White Wine

A.	Estate Riesling QbA - Dr Loosen, Mosel (Germany) 2020 Riesling from Germany is like no other wine, with a wonderful balance of acidity and fruit sweetness, along with appealing aromas of honey, and citrus fruit (even a hint of petrol) Although there is some residual sweetness in this offering from Ernst Loosen, the perfect balancing acidity make it a perfect match for a huge variety of dishes, from Asian spices to Charcuterie and Sauerkraut, 8.5%	Bottle	~	30.00			
B.	Albarino 'Gran Fabian' - Sobreira, Rias Baixas (Spain) 2020 From a family-owned winery situated in a beautiful location on the coast (some outstanding surf beaches are only 5 miles away) where the Salnes Valley meets the Atlantic this is 100% Albariño from hillside vineyards, very fresh with white peach, melon and citrus flavours, leading to a superb mineral 'kick' on the finish. 12.5%	Bottle	~	32.00			
C.	Pinot Blanc - Domaine Henry Fuchs, Ribeauvillé, Alsace (France) 2018 This organic wine comes from 40 year old vines giving more body and complexity to a superb white that has great freshness and is spicy and is not too dry. The 10 hectare estate has been in the Fuchs family since 1922, and gains more accolades year on year. It has been certified organic since 2011. 13%	Bottle	~	35.00			
D.	Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc - Lanark Lane, Marlborough (New Zealand) 2019 Intensely aromatic, crisp and fresh, reflecting the world famous Marlborough style. A real comucopia of gooseberry, passionfruit and white peach, with a zesty acidity, and incredible length. 13%	Bottle	~	35.00			
E.	Sancerre 'Chavignol' - Serge Laporte (France) 2020 Situated in the village of Chavignol, about 2km from Sancerre, this 10 hectare domaine is made up of numerous small parcels scattered throughout the Chavignol commune, long regarded as one of the top 'crus' of Sancerre. The different cuvées come together to give a wine of great complexity and elegance, reflecting the chalky and pebble soil-types found in Chavignol which are so ideal for the Sauvignon Blanc. 12.5%	Bottle	~	45.00			
F.	Chassagne Montrachet 'Les Champs de Morjots' - Yves Girardin (France) 2019 Old vine white burgundy at its finest. On the nose, a concentration of citrus aromas and white stone fruit intermingled with toasted brioche. Rich and full in the mouth with great persistence of flavour and an incredibly long finish. 13.5%	Bottle	~	90.00

G.	Beaujolais Villages Nouveau - Chateau de Grandmont (France) 2021 Certified Organic and Ecocert. "This is one gorgeous little cherry bomb smoking lavender and violet-liquorice laces, tucked into tannins that are only pretending to be there. Almost recklessly juicy and totally scrumptious. Fruit as clear as a silver bell. A lovely tug of earthy mushrooms and minerals on the finish. One of my favourites and at an irresistible price! Lap this up while you can get hold of it!" H.	Chameleon Cabernet/Merlot - Jordan Estate, Stellenbosch (South Africa) 2018 So named because of the number of Chameleons in the vineyards, this is a supple, elegant red blend. Plush textured Merlot fills the framework provided by the Cabernet, leading to approachable flavours of sun-ripened plum and dark-skinned spring berries with a top-note of herbal dried mint. 13.5%	Bottle	~	30.00

l.	Carmenere Reserva 'In Situ' - Vina San Esteban, Aconcagua (Chile) 2018 Aromas of red fruit, spices, smoke and forest tones lead to a medium bodied palate that's soft and fruity with ripe tannins, a silky texture and great elegance. Hand-picked and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel, the wine is aged French and American oak barrels for 12 months before bottling. 13.5%	Bottle	~	32.00
J.	Fleurie - Château de la Chaize, Beaujolais (France) 2019 "pretty aromas of sweet berry fruit, spices, rose petals & orange rind. Medium to full bodied, ample and perfumed with melting tannins and lively acidy. It's pretty and delicate with lovely purity of fruit". ROBERT PARKER, 90pts 12.5%	Bottle	~	45.00
K.	Beaune 1er Cru 'Clos des Vignes Franches' - Château de la Charriere (France) 2017 Wonderfully aromatic with primary cherry and strawberry fruit on the nose, leading into a delicious, full and lively palate with the fruit overtones augmented by spice. Lovely exuberance and a persistent finish. Matured in French oak barrels (30% new) for 10 to 12 months, a light filtration then takes place before bottling which is done in the waning phase of the moon. 13%	Bottle	~	65.00
L.	Chambolle Musigny I er Cru 'Les Charmes' - Domaine Hudelot-Baillet (France) 2009 The appeal is all about the silkiness of the tannins. This exceptionally elegant, sleek Chambolle has a superb elegance. Roses, red berries and sweet spices are some of the nuances that emerge from the glass. The finish is polished and expansive, with a closing burst of candied red fruit that leaves a lasting impression. This wine has not been filtered. 13.5%	Bottle	~	120.00

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

M.	Cremant de Bourgogne Rosé - Caves de Lugny, Burgundy (France) NV A fresh, elegant sparkling rosé made by the traditional method from Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Gamay grapes. Delicate raspberry and ripe strawberry fruit with a light, creamy texture and a long finish. A gorgeous, inexpensive alternative to Champagne, and a perfect aperitif. 11.5%	Bottle	~	35.00
N.	Bollinger Grande Année - Ay, Champagne NV (France) 2012	Bottle	~	190.00

The House of Bollinger only produces vintage champagnes in exceptional years, when the grapes have reached a perfect quality and maturity with a perfect balance between the acids and sugars. Hence the denomination "Grande Année" Refined and elegant, the 2012 is intensely rich and biscuity with a yeasty nose. On the palate powerful flavours of toasted nuts, wild fruits and crème brûlée abound, balanced with lively acidity. 65% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay. 12.5%

Dessert Wines & Port

O. Late Harvest Noble Riesling - Casas del Bosque, Casablanca (Chile) 2018

Made from hand harvested botrytis affected grapes which are carefully selected and picked in the autumn, this delicious sweet wine is aged for 10 months in French Barriques before bottling. Light gold in colour this has a nose of apricot, crème brulée, walnuts and toasted almonds. On the palate there are lush fruity notes of quince, spiced apple and honey combined with a bright zesty acidity to bring it all into balance with excellent structure and length. 12%
