The Quiot family have been producing wine in the Rhone since 1748. A full-bodied, powerful Chateaufneuf with intense black fruits. 14.5%	
30. Terre Del Barolo, Barolo DOCG (Italy) 2012	Bottle ~ 59.00
Medium garnet colour with hints of mature brick; lovely aromas include liquorice, cherry and berries. Great balance between the fruit and tannins. 14%	
31. Gevrey Chambertin Louis Latour (France) 2017	Bottle ~ 95.00
Aromas of lightly-wooded blackcurrant. On the palate blackcurrant and liquorice blend beautifully and accompanied by a slight peppery finish, enhanced by silky tannins. 13.5%
